Description

The project will reconstruct and expand 22.5 miles of I-66 in Virginia from the I-495 Capital Beltway to US 29. The project consists of expanding the existing HOV lanes to two tolled express lanes in each direction that will operate as HOV3+ along the full corridor to University Blvd.
